

Ballot Initiative to Audit the MA Legislature



State Auditor Diana DiZoglio

- The Massachusetts State Auditor is independently elected by the voters and responsible for auditing state taxpayer-funded entities.
- Every state entity has cooperated with regular audits by the State Auditor, except for one: **The Massachusetts State Legislature.**
- Because of the Legislature's refusal to cooperate, countless residents collected over 75k signatures in 2023 to compel the Legislature to be audited.
- The Legislature, again, chose to oppose our efforts.
- We must now collect another nearly 13k signatures to get this issue on the November 2024 ballot.



- We're asking volunteers to help us collect these additional signatures which are due in early June.
- These signatures will only count if they come from voters who didn't already sign one of our petitions from last year.
- You can collect signatures by asking friends and family to sign. You can bring these sheets to BBQs & parties, stand at supermarkets, and/or join our volunteer teams for Days of Action around the state.
- Please email DianaforMassachusetts@gmail.com by June 5th, so we can arrange pick-up/delivery of papers.

- Ask a person if they will sign to audit the Legislature.
- Before they sign, ask them the name of the city or town where they are registered to vote.
- Have them legibly sign their name in the "signature" box, then write their street address in the "now registered at" box, on a sheet that has their corresponding city/town written at the bottom of the page in the "City or Town" box (see the graphic to the right).
 - You've been provided with multiple *blank* sheets so that you can fill in each city/town name based on where you are collecting signatures.
 - If a signature appears illegible, please ask the signer to print their name, in the same box, right next to their signature.
- Sheets with signatures must then be turned into the corresponding, local city/town clerk by the first week of June.
 - For example, a sheet that says "Methuen" must be handed into the Methuen City Clerk.
- Please contact our team to let us know when & where you've dropped off your signature sheets so we can ensure they're counted towards the ballot effort. If you are unable to return sheets to a Clerk, please simply contact us by June 5th and we will coordinate to ensure their pick-up/delivery.
